

1969 Bond Equipe GT Convertible MK II owned by Mr John Eastwood of Rosemarkie



This car is based on a Triumph chassis and has a 2 litre 6 cylinder Triumph engine.

The model was launched in August 1967 and the convertible at the 1968 Motor Show. It was considered expensive at the time—£1095. It was claimed to be capable of 100mph!

Over 800 examples of this model were manufactured but less than half of these were convertibles. Production ceased in August 1970 some time after the company was taken over by Reliant.

John bought the car in Aberdeenshire about 3 years ago and has driven many miles with it since. A very pleasant car to drive according to its delighted owner
