

1925 Bean 14 owned by John Mackay of Scrabster



Johns Bean 14 was first registered in Feb 1925. Bean motor cars were first produced in 1919 and the first model was named the Bean Perry as the company had bought the rights of the earlier Perry motor car. In the mid twenties the model mainly produced was the Bean 14 and it continued in production until 1929 when production of Bean motor cars came to an end.

The Bean was built in Slough and John bought the car at an auction sale in England about 6 years ago. He promptly jumped in the car and set off to drive it home to Scrabster. He almost reached home when the engine cried enough. The engine has since been rebuilt and John drives (not trailers) the car to many shows all over the country.
