Club Rules and Advice

The following Rules and Advice is relevant to all Club Members and non members who attend any event or gathering organised by the HCMC.

1. **Insurance.** Vehicles travelling on public roads must have, as a minimum, valid Third Party Insurance for their current driver.
2. **MOT.** Vehicles travelling on public roads should have a current MOT certificate where relevant (generally under 40 years old). Those vehicles which are exempt (generally over 40 years old) require to be in a roadworthy condition as stated in Law (which suggests maintained to MOT standards). The Club recommends that exempt vehicles should continue to undergo MOT testing on an annual basis.
3. **Road tax.** All vehicles travelling on public roads require to be taxed as required by Law. Vehicles which are exempt from payment (generally over 40 years old) are still required to have the necessary valid documentation.
4. **Speed.** Vehicles at gatherings should be driven at low speeds (generally below 5mph). This is particularly important where members of the public are present and may be unaware of vehicle movements nearby.
5. **Parking.** Vehicles at gatherings should be reverse parked where appropriate.
6. **Courtesy.** Should drivers find themselves in a convoy, vehicles should pull over at suitable safe locations to allow following (and oncoming) traffic to pass safely.
7. **Inappropriate behaviour.** Vehicles travelling to/from gatherings should avoid excessive speed, excess engine revving, wheel spinning or anything which might cause alarm or distress to members of the public.
